LOWER COPAYS FOR PRIMARY CARE, NO COPAY FOR THE HEALTH & **WELLNESS CENTER**

SIA is lowering the copay for a primary care physician visit from \$25 to \$20 in 2019. While not required, it is strongly recommended that all Associates have a regular relationship with a primary care provider (PCP). PCPs can help you navigate the complex healthcare system. They can also direct you to competent specialists or make other referrals when necessary and deliver preventive care (most at no cost to you) to help identify risk factors. PCPs can help prevent or manage chronic disease, and identify drug interactions and minimize dangerous medication risks.

If you are not already engaged with a primary care physician, you may want to establish a relationship with one of the three primary care providers at the SIA Health & Wellness Center. There is no cost for you to use the SIA Health & Wellness Center, which was recently named Center of the Year at Premise Health's annual meeting in Nashville, Tenn.

Michael Cinaflona began in October as SIA's new Recreational Center manager. He sat down and talked about his position, and why he loves what he does.

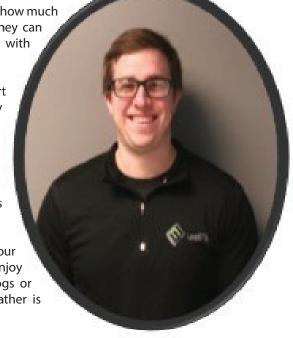
